



COVID-19: Protecting Our Students

With effect from 21st July, the Government has left individual organisations to decide how best to protect their own people.

Consequently, Berkshire Tai Chi will be asking all participants to prove that they are double vaccinated and / or have tested negative for Coronavirus before allowing them to join any of our classes.

They can do this in one of two ways; by using the Covid Pass system devised by the NHS or by presenting the small card they received when jabbed.

Each is explained below.

1. The Covid Pass

How does it work?

You will need to download the NHS App.

(This is not to be confused with the NHS Covid-19 app, which is separate.)

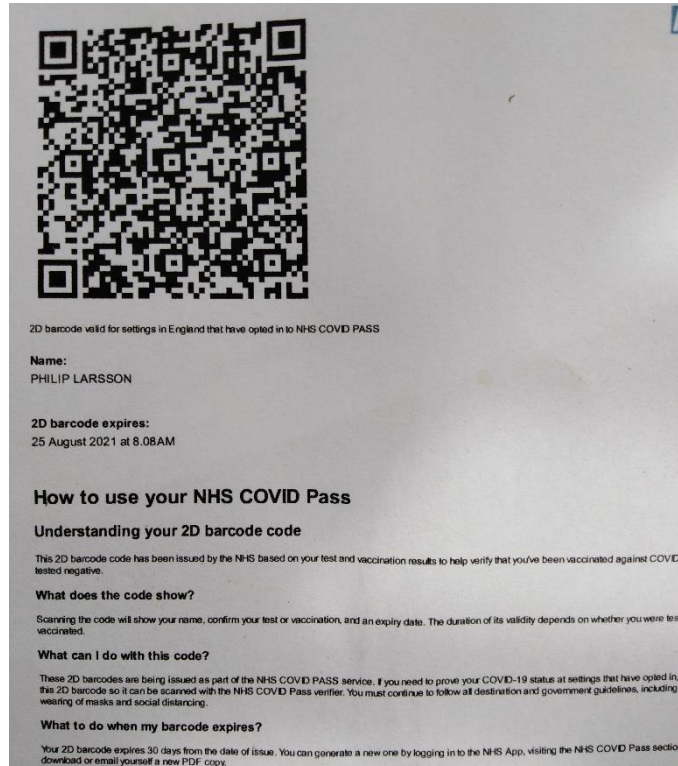
You can download it from either the Apple i-Store or the Google Play Store.

1. Log in.

You will see your Date of Birth and NHS Number.
Below this, you will see **Get your NHS COVID Pass**.
Select this option.

You will be given a QR code which is only valid for 30 days.

It looks like this:



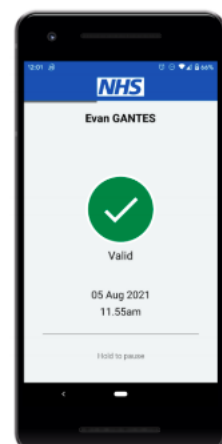
You can either print it out or simply be prepared to show it on the screen of your mobile phone when asked to do so.

As you can see from the example above, there are further instructions accompanying the QR code itself, so that you know how to use it.

2. On arrival at the training hall, present your QR code to the instructor who will scan it using his, or her, mobile phone.

What will we see?

If you are double-jabbed and / or clear of Coronavirus we will see this:



3. You will then be admitted for training.

PLEASE NOTE:

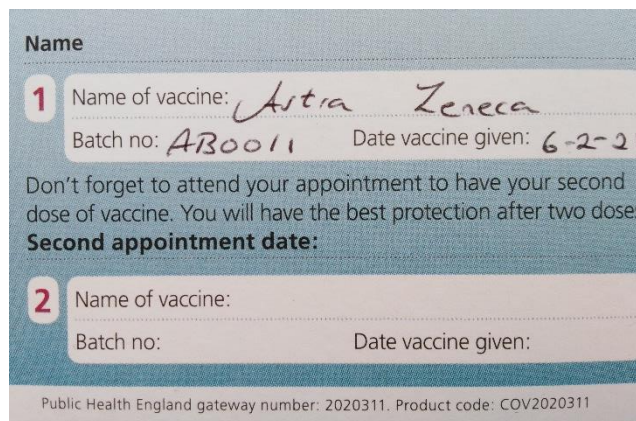
No confidential personal medical information is presented; just a tick to signify that you are safe to be in the group.

2. The Covid Vaccination Record Card

This is the credit card-sized record card which you were issued with at the time of vaccination.

You can show either the card itself, or, if you are worried about losing it, a photo of it.

It looks like this:



Unlike this example, you will have to show two entries on your card.

PLEASE NOTE:

When you book a class, you automatically agree to provide evidence of double vaccination.
